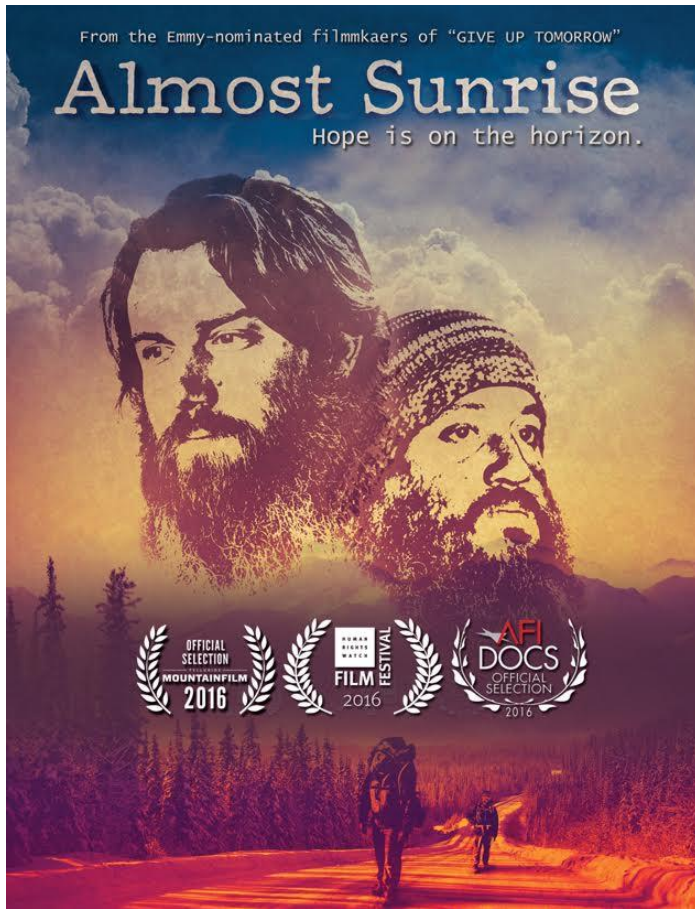


LIMITED SCREENING OF THE AWARD-WINNING DOCUMENTARY

Twenty-two U.S. Veterans commit suicide each day; we lose more Soldiers to suicide than to combat. Join us to explore the psychological wounds plaguing our Soldiers, including the groundbreaking diagnosis of "moral injury".
