Veteran Of The Year Resume Format

- Veteran Of The Year is selected by the Milwaukee County Veterans Association
- The Individual selected will be the Milwaukee County Veteran Of The Year.
- The nominated individual should live in Milwaukee County or be a member of a Veteran Organization in Milwaukee County.
- The nomination format below, must not include the identity of the individual being nominated.
- The identification information must only be on the cover sheet for the nomination.
- Nominations will be evaluated based on information about the nominee, following the criteria listed below.
- Examples are also provided below.

Military Service

Military Service Summary, such as:

Date of entry, location of Basic Training, location of MOS Specialty Training
Significant unit assignments such as 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marine Division,
Overseas service assignments and duration
Date of Discharge
Rank at discharge

Military Service Awards and Medals, such as:

Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal
Navy Occupation Medal
Purple Heart
Army Commendation Medal

Military Service Schools, such as leadership schools and MOS Specialty Schools

NCO Leadership School, Camp Lejeune, N.C.
Weapons Repair Machinist School, Quantico, VA

Service To Veterans Organizations, such as:

Membership in Specific Veteran Organizations
VFW Post,
American Legion Post etc.

Positions held in Specific Veterans Organizations, including local, State and National levels
Served as an Officer (President, Secretary, Quartermaster or Committee Head)

Served as a Delegate to other Veteran Organizations, and positions held
Veterans Board of Directors, Allied Veterans Council etc. (President, Secretary etc.)

Service to the Community, such as:

Church involvement
Scout involvement and awards,
Scoutmaster of Troop #,
Merit Badge Counselor, etc.
Volunteer involvement with other community and Veteran organizations, i.e.
Volunteer at the VA.
Community Awards received
Involvement in professional organizations
